OVERVIEW

The Village is seeking a skilled and dedicated Wastewater Superintendent to lead our newly renovated Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). The Village formerly discharged to a regional system and is currently completing renovations to our WWTF. Wastewater flow through the newly completed WWTF is expected in July/August of 2025.

This role is responsible for supervising and performing technical work in the operation and maintenance of the WWTF; to supervise and perform laboratory tests, maintenance, and repair operations; and for ensuring compliance with environmental regulations, supervising staff, maintaining efficiency in wastewater treatment processes, and optimizing plant performance.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITES

- Supervise and perform the daily operations and maintenance of the wastewater treatment facility.
- Ensure compliance with federal, state, and local environmental regulations.
- Manage and train plant personnel, fostering a safe and productive work environment.
- Oversee budget planning and resource allocation.
- Act as a liaison with government agencies and community stakeholders.
- Develop and implement operational strategies for efficient wastewater treatment.
- Monitor treatment processes and adjust operations as needed.
- Supervise and perform all required analytical testing required for permit compliance.
- Prepare and maintain detailed reports and regulatory documentation.
- Plan and supervise the maintenance, inspection, repair, and construction of mechanical wastewater treatment equipment processes.
- Establish a Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) to track work orders and perform preventative maintenance.
- Related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Considerable knowledge in operating and maintaining a wastewater treatment facility, wastewater pumping, and residuals disposal.
- Considerable knowledge of public health regulations and regulations pertaining to the treatment and disposal of wastewater and wastewater residuals.

- Experience with influent screening, grit removal, MBBR fixed film processes, clarification, and UV Disinfection.
- Experience with aerobic digestion and residuals management including Part 503 regulations.
- Desirable: Bachelor's degree in chemistry, biology, or a related field.

The position involves working indoors and outdoors in all weather conditions, including extreme heat, cold, and wet environments. Additionally, employees must be able to climb ladders, operate heavy machinery, and respond quickly to emergency situations.
